To all to whom these presents shall come or whom the same may

REETING:

Whereas, by the fifteenth section of the Act of Parliament of Canada, used in the forty-third year of Her Majesty's reign, known as "The forth-West Territories Act, 1880," it is amongst other things in effect macted:

That when and so soon as the Lieutenant-Governor is satisfied that ity portion of the North-West Territories, not exceeding an area of one cousand square miles, contains a population of not less than one thousand inhabitants of adult age, exclusive of aliens or unfranchised Interesting in the Lieutenant-Governor shall, by proclamation, erect such portion into an Electoral District by a name and with boundaries to be rejectively declared in the proclamation;

And whereas, I am satisfied that the portion of the North-West Terripries, hereinafter designated, not exceeding an area of one thousand chare miles, contains a population of not less than one thousand inbitants of adult age, exclusive of aliens or unfranchised Indians;

Now know you, that under and by virtue of the powers imposed upon and vested in us by the hereinbefore in part recited section of the said forth-West Territories Act, I do hereby proclaim and declare as follows:

That the portion of Territory comprised in the following group of bwnships and bounded by the outside lines of the outer Townships of the said group, is erected into an Electoral District by the name of

CALGARY,

Jamely: West of Fourth Principal Meridian:

lange XXVIII, Townships numbered 19, 20, 21, 22 and 23;

large XXIX, Township numbered 18 and Fractional Townships numbered 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25;

ange XXX, Fractional Township numbered 18.

West of Fifth Principal Meridian:

Range I, Townships numbered 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24 and 25; Range II. Townships numbered 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24 and 25; RangeIII, Township numbered 25.

Of which all persons whom these presents may concern are hereby required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

In testimony whereof we have caused the seal of the North-West Territories to be hereunto affixed. Witness, His Honor Edgar Dewdney, Lieutenant-Governor of the North-West Territories, at Government House, Regina, this twenty-ninth day of May, in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-Four, and in the forty-seventh year of Her Majesty's reign.
