It is ordered that the land hereinafter described be detached from the Municipal District of Camrose No. 63, and that the same be and are hereby annexed to the City of Camrose:

All that portion of the north-west quarter of section 33, township 45, range 20, west of the fourth meridian in the said Province, which lies north and west of the north-west limit of the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway right-of-way as shown on Railway Plan 8484 A.K.

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.

This Order shall become effective on the 30th day of December, 1961.
