And in the matter of an application by the City of Camrose, in the Province of Alberta, for the annexation to the City of certain adjacent property.

Upon the application of the City of Camrose, in the Province of Alberta; upon reading the consent of the Municipal District of Camrose No. 63; upon reading the consent of the Director of Town and Rural Planning for this Province; upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that:

 Subject to the after-mentioned condition the following described lands be annexed to the City of Camrose as of December 30th, 1958, namely:

All of block X containing 18.05 acres more or less as shown on subdivision plan 4038 A.D., together with all that portion of the Government Road Allowance adjoining the west boundary of the said block and which lies north of the production westerly of the north boundary of lot A as shown on subdivision plan 341 K.S.

And all that portion of Alexander (42nd) Avenue as shown on the said plan 4038 A.D. and 42nd Avenue as shown on the said plan 341 K.S., which lies west of the west limit of 53rd Street drawn throughout. (S.W. 34-46-20-w4).

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.

## Condition

It is a condition of this Order that all small holdings occupied by veterans under the provisions of The Veterans Land Act are to be assessed on the same basis of assessment as would be applicable to them had such parcels remained in the Municipal District of Camrose No. 63 and the maximum rate which the City may tax such lands

shall be the current mill rate of the Municipal District of Camrose No. 63. At the date of ten (10) years from the date of the veteran's agreement or at such time as the veteran is entitled to take title and dispose of his holdings, or part thereof, such holdings, or part thereof, shall be assessed and taxed in the same manner as other properties within the City.
