Upon the application of Herman Sunderman of the Town of Camrose, in the Province of Alberta; for the withdrawal of certain lands from the Town of Camrose; upon reading the consent of the Council of the Town of Camrose; upon reading the consent of the Municipal District of Lloyd George, No. 457; upon reading the consent of The Huron & Erie Mortgage Corporation, and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following lands be separated from the Town of Camrose in accordance with the provisions of Part VI of The Public Utilities Act. 1923:

Firstly: The south-east quarter of Section 10, Township 17, Range 20, west of the Fourth Meridian, confaining 160 acres (more or less).

Secondly: Block "A" as shown on Plan 3510 A.P., a subdivision of the Townsite of Camrose, containing 42.7 acres (more or less).

Thirdly: All that part of the original road allowance which lies between the south-east quarter of said Section 10 and the south-west quarter of Section 11, Township 47, Range 20, west of the Fourth Meridian: Excepting thereout the most southerly 5 chains of the said road allowance.

And it is further ordered that the lands so ordered to be separated be added to and form part of the lands included in the Municipal District of Lloyd George, No. 457.

This Order shall take effect as and from the date of its publication in The Alberta Gazette.
