Before: The Board of Public Utility Commissioners for the Province of Alberta. In the matter of The Public Utilities Act, 1923, and amendments thereto:

And in the matter of an application by William J. Duggan, of Camrose, in the Province of Alberta, for the withdrawal of certain lands from the Town of Camrose:

Upon the application of William J. Duggan, of the Town of Camrose. in the Province of Alberta; upon reading the consent of the Town of Camrose; upon reading the consent of the Municipal District of Lloyd George, No. 457, and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following lands be separated from the Town of Camrose in accordance with the provisions of Part VI of The Public Utilities Act, 1923:

Firstly: Block "B" as shown on Plan 3310 A.P. "Poplar Grove."

Secondly: All that part of the south-west quarter of Section 11, Township 47, Range 20, west of the Fourth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, included within the limit of the land taken for the right-of-way by the Grand Trunk Pacific Branch Lines Company as of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District as Plan No. 3977 Z. containing 7.03 acres, (more or less).

Thirdly: All that part of the south-west quarter of section 11, described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the west boundary of the said quarter section. 5 chains north of the south-west corner thereof; thence easterly and parallel with the south boundary of the said quarter section 5 chains; thence southerly and parallel with the said west boundary to a point in the said south boundary; thence easterly along the said south boundary 5 chains; thence northerly and parallel with the said west boundary 10 chains; thence westerly and parallel to the said south boundary to a point in the said west boundary; thence southerly along the said west boundary to the point of commencement, the land herein described containing 7.5 acres, (more or less).

And it is further ordered that the land so separated be added to and form part of the Municipal District of Lloyd George, No. 457.

This Order shall take effect as and from the date of its publication in The Alberta Gazette.
