DISSOLUTION OF THE VILLAGE OF RANFURLY AND THE LANDS ADDED TO THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF MINBURN, No. 72

Edmonton, Monday, December 31, 1945.

His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order (pursuant to the provisions of Section 25 of The Town and Village Act, being Chapter 150 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942), that the Village of Ranfurly, be, and is hereby declared to be dissolved, as on, and from, January 1st, 1946;

Further, that the lands within the boundaries of the Village of Ranfurly, shall be added to, and form part of the Municipal District of Minburn, No. 72, to be dealt with thereafter under the provisions of The Municipal District Act;

Further, that S. V. Lea, Municipal Inspector, be, and he is hereby appointed, to be the person to adjust and settle the assets and liabilities of the dissolved Village.
