

THE COUNTY ACT

ALTERATIONS IN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE COUNTY OF VULCAN NO. 2

Edmonton, Monday, December 21, 1953.

Whereas the Co-Terminus Boundary Commission has recommended that the boundaries of the County of Vulcan No. 2, be altered to conform with the Commission's Vulcan Co-Terminus Area No. 10; and

Whereas it is considered advisable and expedient to do so;

Therefore, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order (pursuant to the provisions of section 4 of The County Act, being chapter 15 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1950), that the area of the County of Vulcan No. 2 be and is hereby altered according to the Co-Terminus Boundary Commission's recommendations, to include the following:

Part of Special Area No. 4; part of the Municipal District of Barons No. 25; part of the Municipal District of Highwood No. 31; part of the County of Vulcan No. 2; part of the Taber School Division No. 6; part of the Lethbridge School Division No. 7; part of the Foothills School Division No. 38; part of the Bow Valley School Division No. 43; and part of the Vulcan School Division No. 2

so that on and after the first day of January, 1954, the County of Vulcan No. 2 shall be comprised of the following lands:

Those portions of townships 16 and 17 lying westerly of the Bow River, all in range 16.

All of township 16 and that portion of township 17 lying southerly of the Bow River, all in range 17.

All of township 16, all of townships 17, 18, 19 and 20 lying southerly and westerly of the Bow River, all in range 18.

All of townships 16 to 19, inclusive, and that portion of the south half of township 20 lying westerly of the Bow River, all in range 19.

That portion of township 14 lying south and west of the Little Bow River; all of townships 16 to 19, inclusive, and the south half of township 20, all in range 20.

Sections 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31, 32 and the west halves of sections 16, 21, 28 and 33 in township 13; all of township 14 lying southerly and westerly of the Little Bow River; all of township 15 lying west of the easterly boundary of Lake McGregor Reservoir and the canal right-of-way as shown upon a plan of record in the Land Titles Office at Calgary as Irr. No. 164; all of townships 16 to 19, inclusive; and the south half of township 20, all in range 21.

All of township 13, excepting thereout sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 11 and 12; all of townships 14 to 19, inclusive; and those portions of townships 20 and 21 lying south and west of the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146; all in range 22.

All of township 13 excepting thereout sections 1 to 6, inclusive; all of townships 14 to 20, inclusive, and that portion of township 21 lying south of the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146, all in range 23.

All of township 13 excepting thereout sections 1 and 2; all of townships 14 to 20 inclusive; that portion of township 21 lying south and west of the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146, and that portion of township 22 lying south and west of the Bow River and the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146, all in range 24;

Those portions of townships 14 and 15 lying north and east of the Little Bow River; all of townships 16 to 20 inclusive; and those portions of townships 21 and 22 lying southerly of the Bow River; all in Range 25.

Those portions of townships 15, 16 and 17 lying easterly of the Little Bow River; all of township 18; sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36 in townships 19 and 20; sections 1, 12, 13 and those portions of sections 24 and 25 in township 21 lying southerly of the Bow River; all in range 26.

Sections 25, 36 and those portions of sections 13 and 24 in township 17 lying northerly of the Little Bow River; and sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36 in township 18, all in range 27.

All the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian; excepting thereout the land comprising any incorporated town or village situated therein.

Further that the number of electoral divisions shall be increased from nine to eleven and that the electoral divisions shall be as follows:

Division No. 1

That portion of township 14 lying south and west of the Little Bow River, range 20.

Sections 17, 18, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31, 32 and the west halves of sections 16, 21, 28 and 33 in township 13 and all of township 14 lying southerly and westerly of the Little Bow River, all in range 21.

All of township 13, excepting thereout sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 11 and 12; all of township 14, all in range 22.

All of township 13 excepting thereout sections 1 to 6, inclusive; all of township 14, all in range 23.

All of township 13, excepting thereout sections 1 and 2; all of township 14, all in range 24.

That portion of township 14 lying north and east of the Little Bow River in range 25.

All of the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 2

All of townships 15 and 16 lying west of the easterly boundary of Lake McGregor Reservoir and westerly of the canal right-of-way as shown upon a plan of record in the Land Titles Office at Calgary as Irr. No. 164; all in range 21.

All of townships 15 and 16, range 22.

All of townships 15 and 16, range 23.

All the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 3

All of townships 15 and 16, range 24.

All of township 15 lying north and east of the Little Bow River, and the south one-third of township 16, all in range 25.

That portion of township 15 lying easterly of the Little Bow River and that portion of the south one-third of township 16 lying easterly of the Little Bow River, all in range 26.

All of the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 4

The north two-thirds of township 16 and all of township 17 in range 25.

That portion of the north two-thirds of township 16 lying easterly of the Little Bow River; and all of township 17 lying easterly of the Little Bow River; all in range 26.

Sections 25, 36 and those portions of sections 13 and 24 in township 17 lying northerly of the Little Bow River; all in range 27.

All of the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 5

All of township 17 lying west of the easterly boundary of Lake McGregor Reservoir; and that portion of the south half of township 18 lying west of the easterly boundary of Lake McGregor Reservoir; all in range 21.

All of township 17 and all of the south half of township 18; all in range 22.

All of township 17 and all of the south half of township 18; all in range 23.

All of township 17, range 24.

All of the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 6

Those portions of townships 16 and 17 lying westerly of the Bow River, range 16.

All of township 16 and that portion of township 17 lying southerly of the Bow River; all in range 17.

All of township 16 and all of township 17 lying southerly and westerly of the Bow River; all in range 18.

All of townships 16 and 17, range 19.

All of townships 16 and 17, range 20.

All of townships 16 and 17 lying east of the easterly boundary of Lake McGregor Reservoir in range 21.

All of the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 7

All of townships 18, 19 and 20, lying southerly and western of the Bow River, all in range 18.

All of townships 18 and 19 and that portion of the south half of township 20 lying westerly of the bow River; all in range 19.

All of townships 18 and 19 and the south half of township 20, all in range 20.

All of township 18 lying east of the easterly boundary of Lake McGregor Reservoir; all of township 19 and the south half of township 20, all in range 21.

Those portions of sections 25 and 36 in township 18 lying north and east of Lake McGregor Reservoir in range 22.

All of the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 8

That portion of the north half of township 18 lying west of the easterly boundary of Lake McGregor Reservoir in range 21.

All the north half of township 18 excepting thereout those portions of sections 25 and 36 lying north and east of Lake McGregor Reservoir; all of township 19; and those portions of townships 20 and 21 lying south and west of the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146, all in range 22.

The north half of township 18; the east halves of townships 19 and 20, and that portion of the east half of township 21 lying south of the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146, all in range 23.

All the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 9

All of township 18, range 24.

All of township 18, range 25.

All of township 18, range 26.

All of sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36 in township 18, range 27.

All of the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 10

All of the west one-third of township 20; all the west one-third of township 21 lying southerly of the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146; and those portions of township 22 lying south and west of the Bow River and the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146, all in range 24.

All of townships 19 and 20 and those portions of townships 21 and 22 lying southerly of the Bow River, all in range 25.

All of sections 1, 12, 13, 24, 25 and 36 in townships 19 and 20.

Sections 1, 12, 13 and those portions of sections 24 and 25 in township 21 lying southerly of the Bow River, all in range 26.

All the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Division No. 11

All the west halves of townships 19 and 20 and that portion of the west half of township 21 lying south of the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146, all in range 23.

All of township 19; the east two-thirds of township 20 and that portion of the east two-thirds of township 21 lying south and west of the Blackfoot Indian Reserve No. 146, all in range 24.

All the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Further (pursuant to section 25 of The County Act), that insofar as there is no substantial change in electoral divisions numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 and 11 as set out in this Order and those respectively numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 in the former County of Vulcan No. 2, the elected councillors presently holding office for the former electoral divisions numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 continue to hold office as councillors for the new county electoral divisions respectively numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9 and 11 until such time as their present term of office expires.

Further that the two vacancies in the new council created by this Order by the setting up of two new electoral divisions numbered 6 and 10 shall be filled by an election to be held for the position of councillor for each of these divisions in conjunction with the next usual annual election for councillors; and further, that after the successful candidates for these two divisions have taken the oath of office as councillors and after the election of the chairman at the first meeting of the County Council, the person acting as secretary-treasurer shall write the names of these two councillors upon slips of paper and place them in a box or other receptacle and the chairman shall draw one slip from the receptacle. The councillor whose name appears on the slip drawn shall hold office for a term consisting of the period elapsing between the date of the election and the 3rd day of April next following the same and for three years more; the remaining councillor shall hold office for a term consisting of the period elapsing between the date of the election and the 3rd day of April next following the same and for two years more.

Further that at least fifty percent of the cash which remains to the credit of the municipal districts and special area incorporated into the county after all cash and assets of the municipal districts and special area have been appraised and put into balance, shall be spent by the county in the area in which it was accumulated.
