DISSOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF CLIFTON, No. 127,  
AND REVERTED TO THE STATUS OF AN IMPROVEMENT  
DISTRICT

Edmonton, Tuesday, December 14, 1937.

His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order (under the authority of Section 19 of The Municipal District Act, being Chapter 41 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1926), that the Municipal District of Clifton, No. 127, be and is hereby dissolved, as and from the First day of December, 1937, and that after the said date the area now comprising the said Municipal District, shall be known and designated Improvement District No. 127.

Further, that the present Secretary-Treasurer, Kenneth H. Wates, be and he is hereby appointed to adjust and settle the assets and liabilities of the disorganized Municipality, subject to the approval of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, and in accordance with the provisions of Section 19 of The Municipal District Act, and that immediately after dissolution has taken place, all taxes outstanding and unpaid on the Assessment Roll of the Municipal District, be treated as outstanding taxes due and payable to the Department of Municipal Affairs, as if the said taxes had been levied in their entirety by the said Department of Municipal Affairs.

Further, that all machinery, tools, implements, or property of any kind whatsoever, then possessed by the Municipal District of Clifton, No. 127, shall become the property of the said Department of Municipal Affairs, on and after the First day of December, 1937.
