Whereas it has been recommended certain alterations be made to the boundaries of the County of Vulcan No. 2; and

Whereas it is deemed advisable and expedient to implement the said recommendation;

Therefore His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order (pursuant to the provisions of section 4 of The County Act being chapter 15 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1950) that the boundaries of the County of Vulcan No. 2 be and are hereby altered by addition of the following lands, namely:

That portion of the west two-thirds of township 14 lying easterly and northerly of the Bow River; township 15; all in range 20.

That portion of township 14 lying northerly of the Bow River; that portion of township 15 lying easterly of the Bow River; all in range 21.

All of the above described lands lying west of the fourth meridian.

Further that the lands to be added, shall be added for electoral purposes to electoral division No. 6 and that the elected councillors presently holding office in the county shall continue to hold office as councillors until such time as their present term of office expires.

Further that this Order in Council shall be effective on the 1st day of January, 1955, except for the purpose of Certificates of Assessment as required by sections 283 and 296 of The School Act, 1952, and section 73 of The Municipal Hospital Act, for which purpose this Order shall be deemed to have been in effect as of the 31st day of December, 1954.
