# ORDER IN COUNCIL

Approved and ordered:

Lieutenant Governor

The Lieutenant Governor in Council orders that

- (a) effective January 1, 2000, the land described in Appendix A and shown on the sketch in Appendix B is separated from Westlock County and annexed to the Village of Clyde,
- (b) any taxes owing to Westlock County at the end of December 31, 1999 in respect of the annexed land are transferred to and become payable to the Village of Clyde together with any lawful penalties and costs levied in respect of those taxes, and the Village of Clyde upon collecting those taxes, penalties and costs must pay them to Westlock County, and
- (c) the assessor for the Village of Clyde must assess, for the purpose of taxation in 2000, the annexed land and the assessable improvements to it.

ALL THAT PORTION OF THE ROAD ALLOWANCE ADJOINING THE EAST BOUNDARY OF THE NORTHEAST QUARTER OF SECTION 33 (THIRTY-THREE), TOWNSHIP 59 (FIFTY-NINE), RANGE 25 (TWENTY-FIVE), WEST OF THE FOURTH MERIDIAN, WHICH LIES SOUTH OF HIGHWAY 18 ROAD PLAN 2215TR, EXTENDING TO THE WESTERLY PRODUCTION OF THE SOUTH BOUNDARY OF ROAD PLAN 591BM ACROSS AND PERPENDICULAR TO THE WESTERLY BOUNDARY OF THE SAID ROAD ALLOWANCE.
