Under Section 1(f)(iii), a hamlet is an area declared by an order of the Minister to be a hamlet.

I, Julian G. J. Koziak, MINISTER OF MUNICIPAL AFFAIRS, DO HEREBY ORDER:

That for the purpose of the Alberta Street Improvement Program the area described in Schedule "A" and illustrated in Schedule "B" attached hereto, be declared the Hamlet of Moon River Estates.

SCHEDULE "A"

MOON RIVER ESTATES

All of the following lands lying West of the Fourth Meridian.

In Township 9, Range 24;

That portion of the north half of Section 12 included in plan number 7610999, including the east west Government road allowance.

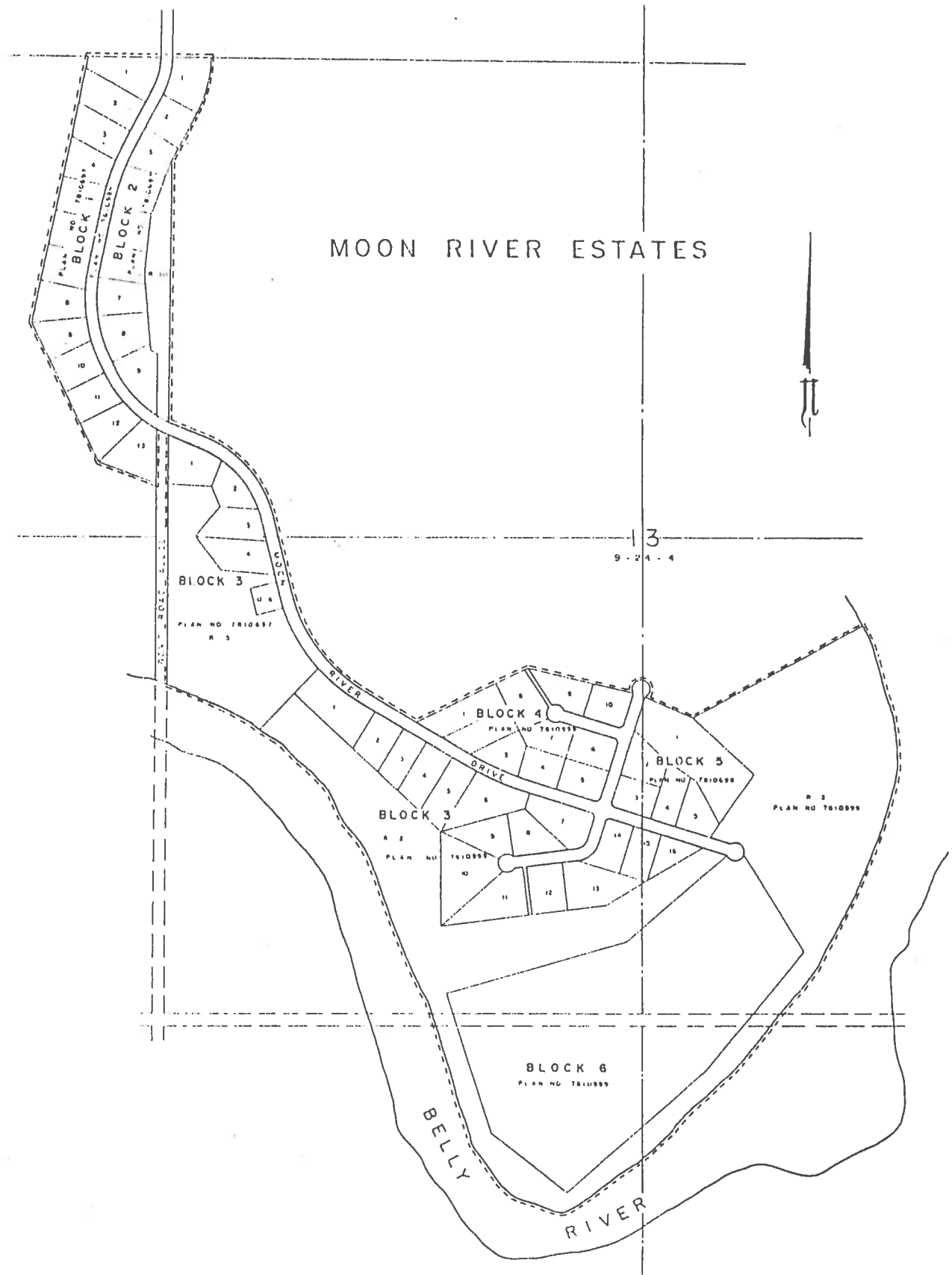
and;

That portion of the south half and north west quarter of Section 13 included in plan numbers 7610697, 7610998 and 7610999, including the north south Government road allowance.

and;

That portion of the north east quarter of Section 14 included in plan number 7610697, including the north south Government road allowance.

SCHEDULE "B"



Claresholm, Alberta, September 12, 1979

By-Law No. 766 was given a second reading. Moved by Housenga that all Councillors present are in agreement to giving By-Law No. 766 a third and final reading.

Carried Unanimously.

Moved by Weatherhead that By-Law No. 766 be given a third and final reading and finally passed and that the Reeve and Secretary-Treasurer be authorized to sign and countersign on behalf of the Municipal District and to affix the corporate seal thereto.

Carried Unanimously.

(t) In regard to the August 8th, 1979 minutes, Item 6(a), re the petition by the ratepayers requesting that Council opt out of the Oldman River Regional Planning Commission, the Council again considered and discussed this matter. After a great deal of deliberation, it was moved by McRae that due to the expense of setting up a Municipal District of Willow Creek Planning Commission that the Municipal District continue to use the services of the Oldman River Regional Planning Commission.

Carried.

(u) Letter received from Alberta Municipal Affairs requesting the Council to designate the various hamlets they wanted to consider as Hamlets for the Street Improvement Program through Alberta Transportation. Moved by Whitehead that the Hamlets of Woodhouse, Orton, Moon River Estates and Parkland be designated Hamlets for the purpose of the Alberta Hamlet Street Improvement Program by Alberta Transportation.

Carried.

(v) Letter received from Alberta Disaster Services in regard to the request for assistance for a radio communication system for the fire departments of five radios and a grant of \$2,500.00. A letter indicated that the Department of Disaster Services was prepared to assist the municipality in the amount of \$2,025.00 for the purchase of three mobile radios. After discussion of this item, it was moved by Whitehead that the Municipal District of Willow Creek proceed with the purchase of five radios for the rural fire service and upon purchase being completed that they make application to Alberta Disaster Services for a grant on three radios.

Carried.

(w) Letter received from Art & Delores Lange and Mel & Mona Koehler requesting the Municipal District's assistance in placing a "Slow - Children Playing" sign on the road adjacent to their property being the
