DISSOLUTION OF THE MUNICIPAL DISTRICT OF ROCKY RAPIDS,  
NO. 522 AND REVERTED TO THE STATUS OF AN  
IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

Edmonton, Thursday, March 4, 1937.

The Honourable the Administrator, by and with the advice of the Executive Council has been pleased to order (in accordance with the provisions of The Municipal District Act, being Chapter 41 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1926, with amendments to date), that the recommendation of the Official Administrator be given effect to, and that the said Municipal District of Rocky Rapids be and is hereby declared to be dissolved on, and after the first day of April, 1937, and that it revert to the status of an Improvement District, as from the said date.

Further, that all arrears of taxes outstanding and unpaid on the Assessment Roll of the said Municipal District, shall as on and after the first day of April, 1937, be payable as taxes due to the Department of Municipal Affairs, in the same way as if the said arrears of taxes had been levied by the said Department of Municipal Affairs.

Further, that all tools, implements or other property of whatsoever kind, now belonging to the said Municipal District of Rocky Rapids, No. 522, shall become the property of the Department of Municipal Affairs on and after the first day of April, 1937, and that James Murray Heaton, now Official Administrator of the aforesaid Municipal District, be, and he is hereby appointed (under Section 19 of The Municipal District Act), to adjust and settle the assets and liabilities of the said Municipal District of Rocky Rapids, No. 522, after dissolution is effected.
