**PURSUANT** to Section 1 of the Improvement Districts Act, I, RAYMOND A. SPEAKER, Minister of Municipal Affairs, as Council for the Improvement District of Yellowhead No. 14, **DO HEREBY ORDER THAT:**

1. The the lands contained within the area outlined on Schedule "A" attached, shall be declared as the Hamlet of Wildwood.
2. The boundaries of the Hamlet of Wildwood shall be established as outlined in Schedule "A" attached, or more specifically defined as:

Part of the North Half of Section Twenty-seven (27), Township Fifty-three (53), Range Nine (9), West of the Fifth (5th) Meridian.

**Background Information**  
**Establishment of the Hamlet of Wildwood**

As of December 31, 1990, the Village of Wildwood was dissolved and became a settlement within the Improvement District of Yellowhead No. 14. Water and sewer systems are in place to service developed areas as well as vacant residential parcels. The location and infrastructure is suited to expansion of both residential and commercial development. It is therefore appropriate to designate the developed areas, as well as some vacant land, as the Hamlet of Wildwood.

The Advisory Council for the Improvement District of Yellowhead No. 14 has recommended that the designation be approved. Signature of the Ministerial Order is recommended.
