THE AREAS OF THE BERRY CREEK-SULLIVAN LAKE SPECIAL AREA AND THE SOUNDING CREEK-NEUTRAL HILLS SPECIAL AREA, AMENDED

His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order (pursuant to the provisions of Section 4 of The Special Areas Act, 1939, being Chapter 34 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1939), that the areas of the Berry Creek-Sullivan Lake Special Area and the Sounding Creek-Neutral Hills Special Area, be and are hereby amended as follows, namely:

The boundaries of the Sounding Creek-Neutral Hills Special Area are amended by adding thereto, and the boundaries of the Berry Creek-Sullivan Lake Special Area are amended by withdrawing therefrom the following described area:

Description:

Commencing at the north-east corner of Township 37, Range 8, west of the Fourth Meridian, thence westerly along the road allowance between Townships 37 and 38 to the north-west corner of Township 37, Range 9; thence southerly along the road allowance between Ranges 9 and 10 to the intersection with the left bank of the Red Deer River; thence in a generally south-easterly and northeasterly direction along the said left bank of the Red Deer River to the intersection with the road allowance between Ranges 7 and 8; thence northerly along the said road allowance between Ranges 7 and 8 to the point of commencement, all west of the Fourth Meridian.
