MINISTERIAL ORDER NO. 384

INCORPORATION OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF GOLDEN DAYS

Whereas, the undersigned being satisfied that all requirements with respect to the incorporation of a Summer Village, under the provisions of The Town and Village Act being chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, and amendments thereto, have been substantially complied with, it is hereby ordered that the area described hereunder namely:

In range 1, township 47, west of the fifth meridian, those parts of the north-east quarter of section 10, the north-west quarter of section 11, the south-east and north-west quarters of section 15 not covered by the waters of Pigeon Lake and the east-west and

north-south road allowances contiguous thereto; that part of the north-east quarter of section 15 commencing at the south-west corner of the aforementioned quarter section a distance of 660 feet north along the west boundary of the quarter section, then 660 feet east to a point, then 660 feet south to the south boundary of the quarter section, then 660 feet west along said boundary to the point of commencement; those parts of section 22 covered by registered plans 170 M.C., 3191 H.W., 2142 H.W., 5278 H.W., 2461 K.S., Block F in registered plan 2993 M.C.; registered plan 4741 K.S. excepting thereout Lot C; and the north-south road allowance contiguous thereto; and that part of the south-east quarter of section 21 lying south of the south boundary of Lot 16. block 8. of registered plan 4843 K.S. not covered by the waters of Pigeon Lake.

Be and it is hereby withdrawn from the County of Leduc No. 25 and erected into a Summer Village to be known as the Summer Village of Golden Days.

It is further ordered that a nomination meeting for the first election of a council be held between the hours of seven o'clock and eight o'clock in the afternoon on Saturday, June 19, 1965, for the purpose of receiving names for the office of councillor.

It is further ordered that if an election is necessary, the polling day shall be Saturday, June 26, 1965, and that the election shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the aforementioned Town and Village Act in that behalf.

It is further ordered that the first meeting of the new council shall be held on Friday, July 2, 1965.

It is further ordered under the authority granted the undersigned by section 17 of The Department of Municipal Affairs Act, being chapter 210 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, that Leonard Lawrence Gurel be and is hereby appointed Official Administrator of the Summer Village from its erection on January 1, 1965, to the first meeting of the new council and that he shall have full power and authority to make the necessary arrangements for the election ordered above.

This Order shall be effective as on and from the first day of January, 1965, except that for the purpose of certificates as required by the Alberta Assessment Equalization Board under the provisions of The Municipal Assessment and Equalization Board Act being chapter 61 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1957, in which case this order is effective as of the 31st day of December, 1964.
