INCORPORATION OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF NAKAMUN PARK

Whereas, the undersigned being satisfied that all requirements with respect to the incorporation of a Summer Village, under the provisions of The Town and Village Act, being chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, and amendments thereto, have been substantially complied with, it is hereby ordered that the area described hereunder namely:

That part of section 34, township 56, range 2, west of the fifth meridian included in registered plans 187M.C., 2302M.C., 1165M.C. and Certificate of Title 68-B208.

That part of the north-south road allowance lying west of the aforementioned section, contiguous to Nakamun Drive, Certificate of Title 68-B-208 and registered plans 2302M.C. and 1165M.C.

That part of the north-south road allowance lying east of the aforementioned section, contiguous to registered plan 187M.C.

Be and it is hereby withdrawn from the County of Lac Ste. Anne, No. 28 and erected into a Summer Village to be known as the Summer Village of Nakamun Park.

It is further ordered that a nomination meeting for the first election of a council be held between the hours of eleven o'clock in the forenoon and twelve o'clock noon on Saturday, June 11, 1966, for the purpose of receiving names of candidates for the office of councillor.

It is further ordered that if an election is necessary, the polling day shall be Saturday, June 25, 1966, and that the election shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the aforementioned Town and Village Act in that behalf.

It is further ordered that the first meeting of the new council shall be held on July 2, 1966.

It is further ordered under the authority granted the undersigned by section 17 of The Department of Municipal Affairs Act, being chapter 210 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, that Donald Forrest Edgar be and is hereby appointed official administrator of the Summer Village from its erection on January 1, 1966, to the first meeting of the new council and that he shall have full power and authority to make the necessary arrangements for the election ordered above.

This order shall become effective as on and from the first day of January, 1966, except that for the purpose of certificates as required by The Alberta Assessment and Equalization Board Act being chapter 61 of the Statutes of Alberta 1957 in which case this order is effective as of the thirty-first day of December, 1965.
