

## ERECTION OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF SILVER BEACH

Whereas, the undersigned being satisfied that all requirements with respect to the incorporation of a summer village under the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, being chapter 97 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1952, and amendments thereto, have been substantially complied with, and

Whereas, it is necessary that provision be made for the holding of an election.

It is hereby ordered that the area described hereunder, namely:

*Firstly:* All that portion of the north-west quarter of section 11, township 47, range 28, west of the fourth meridian in the Province of Alberta not covered, by the waters of Pigeon Lake; and

*Secondly:* All that portion of the south-west quarter of said section 11 contained in a plan of subdivision of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District as Plan 30E.T.; and

*Thirdly:* All that portion of the north-west quarter of section 2, township 47, range 28, west of the fourth meridian contained in a plan of subdivision of record in said Land Titles Office as Plan 4655H.W.

be and it is hereby withdrawn from the Municipal District of Wetaskiwin No. 74, and erected into a summer village to be known as the Summer Village of Silver Beach.

It is further ordered that a nomination meeting for the first election of a council be held between the hours of seven o'clock and eight o'clock in the evening on Saturday, July 3rd, 1954, for the purpose of receiving names of candidates for the office of councillors.

It is further ordered that, if an election is necessary, the polling day shall be Saturday, July 10th, 1954, and that the election shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, in that behalf.

It is further ordered that the first meeting of the new council shall be held on Saturday, July 17th, 1954, at seven thirty o'clock in the evening.

It is further ordered that Thomas Donald Bruce, municipal inspector, be and he is hereby appointed official administration of the village from its erection on December 31st, 1953, to the first meeting of the new council and that he shall have full power and authority to make all arrangements necessary for the election above ordered.

This order shall be effective as on and from the 31st day of December, 1953.
