Appendix "A"

SUMMER VILLAGE OF BONDISS

**In township 65, range 18, west of the fourth meridian**

**All that portion of the north-west quarter of section 5 not covered by the waters of Skeleton Lake**

**All that portion of the north-east quarter of section 5 lying north of the south boundary of road plan 3629KS and not covered by the waters of Skeleton Lake**

**All that portion of the south-east quarter of section 7 not covered by the waters of Skeleton Lake**

**All that portion of the south-west quarter of section 8 lying south of the north limit of the extension of Spruce Drive as shown on plan 6249MC and covered by an unregistered survey made under the supervision of Alberta land surveyor Lawrence M Pals of Edmonton, between October 16 and October 30, 1982 and not covered by the waters of Skeleton Lake**

**All that portion of the north-south road allowance between sections 7 and 8 lying south of the extension easterly of the north boundary of Spruce Drive as shown on plan 6249MC and not covered by the waters of Skeleton Lake**

**All that portion of the north-south road allowance lying between the north-west quarter of section 5 and the north-east quarter of section 6 and not covered by the waters of Skeleton Lake**
