The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated November 21st, 1946, stating that:

WHEREAS the Council of the VILLAGE OF BARRHEAD has expressed to the Minister of Municipal Affairs the desire that the said Village be formed into a Town; and

WHEREAS the said Village contains over seven hundred inhabitants; and

WHEREAS the aforesaid desire has been approved by more than two-thirds of the electors of the Village voting thereon; and

<u>WHEREAS</u> the Secretary-Treasurer of the Village has furnished satisfactory proof of compliance with the provisions of THE TOWN AND VILLAGE ACT with respect to the required formalities in the formation of a Town;

THEREFORE, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that the proposal to form the Village of Barrhead into a Town be acceded to, and that a PROCLAMATION do issue forming the said Village of Barrhead into a Town, so that on and after the date of the said Proclamation

the Village of Barrhead shall be known and designated as the TOWN OF BARRHEAD, and shall consist of the following area:

All that portion of the North-east quarter of Section 20, lying north of the left bank of the Paddle River; the North-west quarter of Section 21 together with the Government road allowance lying to the west thereof. All the above descirbed land being in Township 59, Range 3, West of the Fifth Meridian. (2)

Also that portion of the South-west quarter of Section 28, Township 59, Range 3, West of the Fifth Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the south-west corner of the said quarter section; thence north along the western boundary of the said quarter section a distance of 1,320.01 feet, to a point; thence easterly and parallel to the southern boundary cof the said quarter section, a distance of 1,404 feet to a point; thence southerly and parallel to the west boundary of the said quarter section, a distance of 1,320.01 feet (more or less) to the south boundary of the said quarter section; thence westerly along the said south boundary a distance of 1,404 feet (more or less) to the point of commencement, the said lands being more particularly described in Certificate of Title, of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District as Nos. 29-X-109, 123-H-88, 173-I-67, 220-T-68 and 118-C-104.

and that such Proclamation be published in The Alberta Gazette.

The Executive Council further advises, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, that, in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, the present Council of the Village shall, until the third konday in February next following the date of the Proclamation, be deemed to be the Council of the Town of Barrhead, and the said Council shall prepare for the election of a Mayor and six Councillors to take office on the third monday in February, 1947, in accordance with the provisions of the said The Town and Village Act in that behalf, and the terms of office of the Councillors so elected shall be governed by the provisions of Section 49 of the said The Town and Village Act.

TO HIS HONOUR, THE LIEUTENANT-GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Barrhead has expressed to the undersigned the desire that the said Village be formed into a Town; and

WHEREAS the said Village contains over seven hundred inhabitants; and

WHEREAS the aforesaid desire has been approved by more than two-thirds of the electors of the Village voting thereon; and

WHEREAS the Secretary-Treasurer of the Village has furnished satisfactory proof of compliance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act with respect to the required formalities in the formation of a Town.

NOW, THEREFORE, the undersigned has the honour to recommend that the proposal to form the Village of Barrhead into a Town be acceded to, and that a Proclamation to that effect be published in the Alberta Gazette, so that, on and after the date of the said Proclamation, the Village of Barrhead shall be known and designated as the Town of Barrhead, and shall consist of the following area:-

All that portion of the North-east quarter of Section 20, lying north of the left bank of the Paddle River; the North-west quarter of Section 21 together with the Government road allowance lying to the west thereof. All the above described land being in Township 59, Range 3, West of the Fifth Meridian.

Also that portion of the south-west quarter of Section 28, Township 59, Range 3, West of the Fifth Meridian, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the south-west corner of the said quarter section; thence north along the western boundary of the said quarter section a distance of 1,320.01 feet, to a point; thence easterly and parallel to the southern boundary of the said quarter section, a distance of 1,404 feet to a point; thence southerly and parallel to the west boundary of the said quarter section, a distance of 1,320.01 feet (more or less) to the south boundary of the said quarter section; thence westerly along the said south boundary a distance of 1,404 feet (more or less) to the point of commencement, the said lands being more particularly described in Certificates of Title, of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District, as Nos. 29-X-109, 123-H-85, 173-I-67, 220-T-65 and 115-C-104.

It is further recommended that, in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, the present Council of the Village shall, until the third Monday in February next following the date of the Proclamation, be deemed to be the Council of the Town of Barrhead, and that the said Council prepare for the election of a Mayor and six Councillors to take office on the third Monday in February, 1947, in accordance with the provisions of the said Town and Village Act in that behalf, and that the terms of office of the Councillors so elected shall be governed by the provisions of Section 49 of the said Town₄ and Village Act.
