Upon the application of the council of the Village of Bashaw for an Order annexing to the Village certain territory adjacent thereto, upon reading the Resolution of the Council, the consent of the Municipal District of Ponoka, No 66, and of a majority of the owners of properties affected, and the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following outlying adjacent areas be annexed to the Village of Bashaw in accordance with the provisions of section 21 of The Town and Village Act, viz,

(a) All of the lands included in a plan of subdivision of the west half of section 4, township 42, range 21, west of the fourth meridian in the Province of Alberta, as shown on Plan of Subdivision of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District as Plan 1527 H W, excepting thereout Lot A containing 39 48 acres, Lot F containing 81 98 acres, and that portion of New Franklin Boulevaid lying north-west of the north limit of Varsity Avenue as shown on said plan 1527 H W.

(b) All of the lands included in Plan of Subdivision of the west half of section 4, township 42, range 21, west of the fourth meridian in the said Province, of record in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District as Plan 429 H W

This order shall take effect as and from the 1st day of January, 1950
