And in the matter of an application by the Village of Bashaw for annexation of certain adjacent territory.

Upon the application of the Village of Bashaw, in the Province of Alberta, for an Order to include within the said Village certain territory adjacent thereto; and upon hearing the petition of the Village, the representation of the County of Camrose No 22, the Counsel for the owner of part of the lands included in the petition, and other interested parties thereto; and upon considering the evidence adduced at a public hearing held in the Village of Bashaw on the 30th of January, 1964, and upon considering other relevant material filed with the Board:

It is ordered that the lands hereinafter described namely

Firstly All the land subdivided under Subdivision Plans 6632 M C and 362N Y

Secondly All that portion of Block F as shown on Subdivision Plan 1527 HW bounded as follows

On the north-west by the south-east boundary of Lot 6, Block 38 of Subdivision Plan 6632 M C

On the north-easterly by the lane as shown on the said Plan 6632 M C

On the south-easterly by the north-westerly limit of Varsity Avenue as shown on Subdivision Plan 1527 HW

and on the south-west by the north-easterly limit of New Franklin Blvd as shown on the said Plan 1527 H $\mathrm{W}^{||}$

be and the same are hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Bashaw and are detached from the County of Camrose No 22

It is further ordered that the Village Assessor shall, for taxation purposes in 1964, assess the annexed properties on a uniform basis with other properties in the Village.

It is also a condition of this Order that the taxes owing to the County of Camrose No 22 as at December 31, 1963, in respect to the aforesaid property, shall transfer to and become payable to Village of Bashaw, together with the sum of any lawful penalties and costs levied thereon in respect of such tax arrears, until all such taxes, penalties and costs are paid in full, however, upon the Village of Bashaw collecting any or all of the said taxes, penalties and costs, such collections shall forthwith be paid by the Village of Bashaw to the County of Camrose No 22

This Order shall take effect on, as and from the 1st day of January,
