All of Lot L containing 16 11 acres, more or less, and all of Lot M containing 16 90 acres, more or less, as shown on Subdivision Plan 723 M C together with all that portion of the Original Government Road Allowance adjoining the west boundary of the north-west quarter of section 4, township 42, range 21, west of the fourth meridian, which lies north of the production westerly of the south boundary of the said Lot L and south of the production north-westerly of the northerly boundary of the said Lot M.
