In the matter of "The Town and Village Act" being chapter 338 of The Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955;

And in the matter of an application by the Town of Beaverlodge, in the Province of Alberta, for the annexation of certain lands.

Upon the application of the Town of Beaverlodge; upon reading the consent of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1; upon reading the consent of the Director of Town and Rural Planning for this Province; upon reading the consent of the owners of the property concerned; upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the lands hereinafter described be detached from the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 and that the same be and are hereby annexed to the Town of Beaverlodge:

All that portion of the south-east quarter of section 11, township 72, range 10, west of the sixth meridian, in the said Province, described as follows

Firstly. All of the land subdivided under subdivision plan 3560 K S Containing 7 54 acres, more or less

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals

Secondly All of lot 3 and all that portion of lot 2 not subdivided under the said plan 3560 K S as shown on subdivision plan 5314 H W. Containing 1 85 acres, more or less

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals

This order shall become effective on the 30th day of December, 1958.
