nexation of a certain roadway  
immediately adjacent to the Town  
of Beaverlodge.

Whereas in the course of investigating an application filed with the Board by the Town of Beaverlodge under the date of Decemer 22, 1965, the Board's attention was drawn to the fact that a parcel of land consisting of a roadway, shown on Subdivision Plan 6758 K.S. and measuring 33 feet in width and lying immediately south of an adjoining Lot A, Plan 6758 K.S. should be annexed to the town; and

Whereas the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 has filed with the Board its consent to the annexation of the aforesaid roadway to the Town of Beaverlodge; and

Whereas the Department of Highways, under date of January 14, 1966, has no objection to the proposed annexation:

Now, therefore, pursuant to the provisions of section 18 of The Town and Village Act, the Board orders that there be separated from the County of Grande Prairie No. 1 and annexed to the Town of Beaverlodge, in the Province of Alberta, all of the 33 foot street within the south-west quarter of section 11, township 72, range 10, west of the sixth meridian, as shown on Subdivision Plan 6758 K.S and which adjoins the south boundary of Lot A as shown on the said Plan.

(A sketch showing the general location of the annexed land is attached to this order as Schedule "A".)

This order shall take effect as, on and from the 1st day of January, 1966.
