Upon the application of the Town of Beaverlodge, in the Province of Alberta; upon reading the consent of the County of Grande Prairie No. 1; upon reading the consent of the Peace River District Planning Commission; upon reading the consent of the owners of the property concerned; and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following lands be detached from the County of Grande Prairie No. 1, and that the same be and is hereby annexed to the Town of Beaverlodge:

**Firstly:** All that portion of the south-east quarter of section 2, township 72, range 10, west of the sixth meridian in the said Province subdivided under Subdivision Plan 5484KS. Containing, 11 22 acres, more or less.

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.

**Secondly:** All that portion of the said south-east quarter shown as the Edmonton, Dunvegan & British Columbia Railway's right-of-way as shown on Railway Plan 1209EO

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals

**Thirdly.** All that portion of the said south-east quarter shown as road on Road Plan 2973JY and 627EO which lies east of the production southerly of the east boundary of Subdivision Plan 8358ET.

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals

**Fourthly** All that portion of the original Government Road Allowance adjoining the south boundary of the said south-east quarter which lies west of the production southerly of the east limit of Second Avenue East as shown on said Plan 5484KS. and east of a line drawn at right angles to the north limit of the said road through a point of intersection of the north limit of the said road and the south-westerly limit of the said Railway as shown on Railway Plan 1209EO

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals

This Order shall become effective on the 30th day of December, 1959.
