All that portion of the said south-east quarter of section 2, township 72, range 10, west of the sixth meridian shown as road on Road Plan 4589 EU: which lies east of the easterly limit of the road as shown on Road Plan 2973 J.Y. and west of the production southerly of the east limit of Second Avenue East as shown on Plan 5484 K.S.

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.
