ORGANIZATION OF THE VILLAGE OF BEAVERLODGE

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with the provisions of The Village Act in that behalf, that, by order of the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated the thirty-first day of July, 1929, the following area, namely:—

Commencing at the south-west corner of the north-east quarter of Section 2, Township 72, Range 10, West of the Sixth Meridian; thence easterly a distance of 266 feet along the south boundary of said quarter-section; thence northerly and parallel to the west boundary thereof to the intersection with the north boundary of said Section 2; thence westerly along said north boundary to the intersection with the production north-easterly and in a straight line of the north-westerly boundary of Twelfth Street as shown on registered plan No. 729-EO; thence south-westerly along said production and said north-westerly boundary and the production south-westerly thereof and in a straight line to the intersection with the north-easterly boundary of the Edmonton, Dunvegan and British Columbia Railway's station grounds, as shown on Railway Plan No. 1209-EO; thence northwesterly along said north-easterly boundary to the intersection with the west boundary of Section 11; thence southerly along said west boundary and the west boundary of Section 2 to the intersection with the south-westerly boundary of the station grounds aforesaid; thence south-easterly along said south-westerly boundary to the intersection with the east boundary of the south-west quarter of Section 2; thence northerly along said east boundary to the intersection with the north-easterly boundary of the station grounds aforesaid; thence north-westerly along said north-easterly boundary to the intersection with the production south-westerly in a straight line of the south-easterly boundary of Eighth Street as shown on registered Plan No. 729-EO; thence north-easterly along said production and said south-easterly boundary to

the intersection with the south boundary of the north-west quarter of Section 2 aforesaid; thence easterly along said south boundary to the point of commencement—

was withdrawn from Improvement District No. 771, and erected into a village, to be known by the name of the “Village of Beaverlodge.”
