The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated January 19th, 1956, stating that:

WHEREAS a request has been received from the Council of the Village of Beaverlodge to have the village proclaimed a town; and

WHEREAS the said village contains over seven hundred inhabitants; and

WHEREAS the Secretary-Treasurer of the Village has furnished satisfactory proof of compliance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, with respect to the required formalities applicable to the formation of a Town;

THEREFORE, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that the proposal to form the Village of Beaverlodge into a Town shall be acceded to, so that on and from the date of this Order, the Village of Beaverlodge shall be known and designated as the TOWN OF BEAVERLODGE and shall be comprised of the following lands:

Those portions of Sections 2 and 11 of Township 72, Range 10, West of the 6th Meridian described as follows:

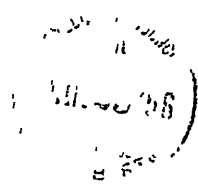
- (1) All of the station grounds and right-of-way of the Northern Alberta Railways in the West half of Section 2 as shown on a plan registered in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District, Edmonton, as Railway Plan 1209 E.O.

- (2) That portion of the West half of Section 2 lying North and East of the Northern Alberta Railways station grounds and right-of-way as shown on Railway Plan 1209 E.O.
- (3) That portion of the South East quarter of Section 2 lying South and West of the Northern Alberta Railways right-of-way as shown on Railway Plan 1209 E.O.
- (4) Those portions of the East half of Section 2 covered by plans registered in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District, Edmonton, as 8358 E.T., 4463 E.O., 1190 H.W., 5627 H.W. and that portion of the surveyed road lying West of the projection southerly of the East boundary of Plan 8358 E.T. to the northerly limit of the railway right-of-way as shown on Railway Plan 1209 E.O.
- (5) Those portions of the South half of Section 11 covered by plans registered in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District, Edmonton, as 644 H.W., 409 K.S. and 5135 H.W.
- (6) That portion of the surveyed road between Sections 2 and 11 lying West of the projection northerly of the East boundary of Lot 1 of Plan 1190 H.W.

The Executive Council further advises, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, that in accordance with the provisions of section 29 of The Town and Village Act, 1952, the present Council of the Village of Beaverlodge shall be deemed to be the Council of the Town of Beaverlodge until the second Monday in March, 1956, and that the said Council shall prepare for the election of a Mayor and six Councillors to take office on the second Monday in March, 1956, in accordance with the provisions of the said The Town and Village Act, 1952, and that the terms of office of the Mayor and Councillors so elected shall be governed by the provisions of sections 43 and 98 of The Town and Village Act, 1952.

TO HIS HONOUR
THE LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, a request has been received from the Council of the Village of Beaverlodge to have the Village proclaimed a Town; and

WHEREAS, the said Village contains over seven hundred inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the Secretary-Treasurer of the Village has furnished satisfactory proof of compliance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, with respect to the required formalities applicable to the formation of a Town.

NOW THEREFORE, the undersigned has the honour to recommend that the proposal to form the Village into a Town be acceded to and an Order-in-Council be issued so that on and from the date of the Order, the Village of Beaverlodge shall be known and designated as the Town of Beaverlodge and shall be comprised of the following lands:

Those portions of Sections 2 and 11 of Township 72, Range 10, west of the 6th meridian described as follows:

- (1) All of the station grounds and right-of-way of the Northern Alberta Railways in the west half of Section 2 as shown on a plan registered in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District, Edmonton as Railway Plan 1209 E.O.
- (2) That portion of the west half of Section 2 lying north and east of the Northern Alberta Railways station grounds and right-of-way as shown on Railway Plan 1209 E.O.
- (3) That portion of the south-east quarter of Section 2 lying south and west of the Northern Alberta Railways right-of-way as shown on Railway Plan 1209 E.O.

- (4) Those portions of the east half of Section 2 covered by plans registered in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District, Edmonton as 8358 E.T., 4463 E.O., 1190 H.W., 5627 H.W. and that portion of the surveyed road lying west of the projection southerly of the east boundary of plan 8358 E.T. to the northerly limit of the railway right-of-way as shown on Railway Plan 1209 E.O.
- (5) Those portions of the south half of Section 11 covered by plans registered in the Land Titles Office for the North Alberta Land Registration District, Edmonton as 644 H.W., 409 K.S. and 5135 H.W.
- (6) That portion of the surveyed road between Sections 2 and 11 lying west of the projection northerly of the east boundary of Lot 1 of plan 1190 H.W.

IT IS FURTHER RECOMMENDED THAT, in accordance with the provisions of Section 29 of The Town and Village Act, 1952, the present Council of the Village of Beaverlodge shall be deemed to be the Council of the Town of Beaverlodge until the second Monday in March, 1956, and that the said Council prepare for the election of a Mayor and six Councillors to take office on the second Monday in March, 1956, in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, 1952, and that the terms of office of the Mayor and Councillors so elected shall be governed by the provisions of Sections 43 and 98 of The Town and Village Act, 1952.
