Under the provisions of The Village Ordinance, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to Order the establishment of that portion of the south-west quarter of Section 26 lying west of the Calgary and Edmonton trail, as shown by a survey made by George P Roy, Dominion Land Surveyor, in the year 1886, and the south-east quarter of Section 27, all in Township 39 Range 27 west of the Fourth Meridian as a Village under the name of Blackfalds, that Monday the Twenty-seventh day of June, 1904, be the day fixed for the election of an Overseer of the said Village, and that Percy B Gregson, of Blackfalds, Alberta, be appointed to act as Returning Officer at the said election.
