<u>WHEREAS</u> the Council of the Village of Blackfalds has, by resolution, made a request to have the village formed into a town and has furnished satisfactory proof that the requirements requisite to the formation of a town have been complied with:

THEREFORE, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Lieutenant Governor in Council, pursuant to section 14(1)(d) of The Municipal Government Act, orders that the Village of Blackfalds be formed into the TOWN OF BLACKFALDS, effective April 1, 1980, to consists of the lands described in the attached Appendices "A" and "B".

APPENDIX "A"

TOWN OF BLACKFALDS

In township 39, range 27, west of the fourth meridian

That portion of the north west quarter of section 23 which lies north west of the north westerly limit of registered road plan 3932 E.U.

That portion of the west half of section 26 lying west of the westerly boundary of registered road plans 4011 E.U. and 3932 E.U.

All of the east half of section 27.

The easterly sixty-six (66) feet throughout of the south west quarter of section 27, excepting thereout all that portion which lies north and west of a line drawn from the north east corner of said quarter section, in a south westerly direction at an angle of twenty nine degrees (29°) fifty one (51) feet forty (40) inches.

That portion of the east west government road allowance lying north of the north west quarter of section 23 and west of road plan 3932 E.U.

That portion of the east west government road allowance lying north of the north west quarter of section 22.
