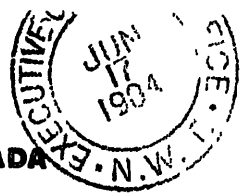
R E G I N A, FRIDAY, JUNE 17, 1904.

Upon the recommendation of the Commissioner of Public Works, bearing even date, all the requirements of The Village Ordinance with respect to the establishment of villages having been complied with, the Executive Council advises that, under the provisions of The Village Ordinance in that behalf, that portion of the south-west quarter of section 26 lying west of the Calgary and Edmonton Trail, as shown by a survey made by George P. Roy, Dominion Land Surveyor, in the year 1886, and the south-east quarter of section 27, all in township 39 range 27 west of the Fourth Meridian, be established as a Village under the name of Blackfalds; that Monday the twenty seventh day of June 1904, be the day fixed for the election of an Overseer of the said Village, and that Percy B. Gregson, of Blackfalds, Alberta, be appointed Returning Officer at the said election.

The Lieutenant Governor in Council.

The undersigned has the honour to report that, having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder, is not included within any incorporated City, Town or rural Municipality and that the said area contains not less than fifteen occupied dwelling houses, he has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of The Village Ordinance, caused notices to be posted in three conspicuous places, one of which was the Post Office, within the area announcing the intention to establish the area as a Village at the expiration of thirty days from the date of posting said notices:

He further reports that such notices were posted at least thirty days prior to the date hereof :

The undersigned therefore begs to recommend that, under the provisions of Section 4 of The Village Ordinance, that portion of the South-West quarter of Section Twenty-six (26) lying West of the Calgary and Edmonton Trail, as shown by a survey made by George P. Roy, D.L.S., in the year 1886, and the South-East quarter of Section Twenty-seven (27) all in Township Thirty-nine (39) Range Twenty-seven (27) West of the Fourth Meridian be established a Village; that the Village be given the name of ' B L A C K F A L D S ; that Percy B. Gregson, of Blackfalds, Alberta, be appointed Returning Officer to

act at the election of an Overseer for the Village; and that the said election for an Overseer for the Village in question be held on Monday the twenty-seventh day of June, 1904.
