And in the matter of a petition of the Council of the Village of Bowden for the annexation to the Village of territory adjacent thereto.

Upon the petition of the Council of the Village of Bowden for an Order of The Board of Public Utility Commissioners including within the said Village certain territory adjacent thereto:

And upon reading a copy of the Resolution of the Council of the Village of Bowden, the written consent of the Municipal District of Red Deer No. 55 and a majority of the owners, of the parcels proposed to be annexed:

It is ordered that the following parcels of land; viz.,

(a) A portion of the south-west quarter of section 23, township 34, range 1, west of the fifth meridian, in the Province of Alberta, which lies northerly and easterly of the northerly and easterly boundaries of the roadway shown on Plan 6690 B.M. southerly of the southerly limit of block A as said block A is shown on a plan of record as Bowden 1905 H, and westerly of the westerly limit of the right-of-way of the Calgary and Edmonton Railway, as said right-of-way is shown on Plan R.Y. 9, containing .383 of an acre more or less;

(b) All that portion of the east half of section 23, township 34, range 1, west of the fifth meridian, subdivided under plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the south Alberta Land Registration District as Plan 5098 G.E.;

be and the same are hereby annexed to and included in the Village of Bowden.

And it is further ordered that this Order shall take effect as and from the 1st day of January, 1951.
