And in the matter of the appli-  
cation by Edwin Walter Shenfield  
of Bowden, for the separation of  
portions of the north half of  
Section 23, Township 34, Range 1,  
west of the 5th Meridian, com-  
prising 162 acres more or less,  
from the Village of Bowden.

Upon hearing the applicant Edwin Walter Shenfield, and upon  
hearing the objections of the Village of Bowden, and upon rending the  
other material filed:

It is ordered that the following lands, namely :

All those portions of the north half of Section 23 in Township 34  
in Range 1, west of the 5th Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, lying  
east of the easterly limit of Railway Street and north of the northerly  
limit of Hammond Street as said streets are shown on a plan of record  
in the South Alberta Land Registration District as Bowden 1905-H.,  
excepting thereout the following portions thereof:

(a) That covered by plan Bowden 1905-H.;

(b) That covered by plan Bowden 3942-J.;

(c) That covered by plan Bowden 1954-S.;

(d) That portion sold to the Bowden Agricultural Society under  
Agreement 107 Bowden, described as follows: Beginning at a point  
on the easterly limit of said quarter section where it intersects with the  
north limit of Hammond Street as said street is shown on plan registered  
in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration  
District as Plan 1954-S; thence northerly along the eastern boundary  
of said quarter section a distance of 601.2 feet; thence south-westerly  
parallel with the northerly limit of said Hammond Street a distance  
of 1,113 feet more or less to the northerly production of the easterly  
limit of Munson Street, as said street is shown on said Plan 1954-S.;  
thence south-easterly along said production and said easterly limit  
of Munson Street a distance of 586 feet to the northerly limit of said  
Hammond Street; thence north-easterly along the north limit of said  
Hammond Street a distance of 977.4 feet more or less to the point of  
commencement beseparated from the Village of Bowden, in accordance  
with the provisions of Section 86a of The Public Utilities Act.
