of Bowden, in the Province of
Alberta, farmer, for the separation
of portion of the south-east quar-
ter of Section 23, Township 34,
Range 1, west of the 5th Meridian,
comprising 114.75 acres more or
less, from the Village of Bowden.

Upon hearing the applicant., John Cameron Turnbull, upon hearing
the objections of the Tillage of Bowden and upon reading the other
material filed :

It is ordered that the following lands, namely:

All that portion of the south-east quarter of Section 23, in Township
34, Range 1, west of the Fifth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta,
lying east, of theeasterly limit of the C. & E. Railway right-of-way,
which said right-of-way is shown on plan thereof filed in the Land
Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as "Ry.
9," save and except those portions covered by surveyed plans or pro-
perty sold by metes and bounds description. And also that portion
of the north-east quarter of said Section 23, Township 34, Range 1,
west of the Fifth Meridian lying between the southerly limit of Ham-
mond Street and the south boundary of the north-east quarter of said
Section 23, as said street is shown on plan on file in the Land Titles
Office aforesaid as "Bowden No. 1905 H," the area of the land con-
tained in above description being 114.75 acres more or less, according
to the Dominion Government survey be separated from the Village
of Bowden in accordance with the provisions of Section 86a of The
Public Utilities Act.
