And also that portion of the north-east quarter of said Section 23, Township 34, Range 1, west of the Fifth Meridian lying between the southerly limit of Hammond Street and the south boundary of the north-east quarter of said Section 23, as said street is shown on plan on file in the Land Titles Office aforesaid as "Bowden No. 1905 H," the area of the land contained in above description being 114.75 acres more or less, according to the Dominion Government survey be separated from the Village of Bowden in accordance with the provisions of Section 86a of The Public Utilities Act.
