Upon the application of the Village of Bowden, in the Province
of Alberta; upon reading the consent of the Municipal District of Red
Deer No. 55; upon reading the consent of the Red Deer District
Planning Commission; upon reading the consent of the owners of the
properties concerned; and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following land be detached from the Muni-
cipal District of Red Deer No. 55, and that the same be and **is** hereby
annexed to the Village of Bowden.

That portion of the east half of section 23, township 34, range
I, west of the fifth meridian, not at present within the boundaries
of the Village and which lies to the south of Hammond Street
according to a plan of record in the Land Titles Office for the
South Alberta Land Registration District as Bowden 1905 H. and
to the east of the Railway as shown on a plan deposited in the
said Land Titles Office as R.Y. 8.

'Reserving unto the Calgary and Edmonton Corporation Limited
all minerals as set forth in Transfer 2334 E.K.

This Order shall become effective **on** the 1st day of July, 1960.
