In the matter of The Village Act, 1927,

And in the matter of an application by the Village of Bowden for the annexation of certain lands to the Village of Bowden.

Upon the petition of the Council of the Village of Bowden; upon hearing the Secretary-Treasurer of the Village of Bowden and other interested parties; and upon reading the material filed in support of the **said** application:

It is ordered that the following parcel of land be annexed to the Village of Bowden, in accordance with the provisions of Section '15 of The Village Act, 1927:

All that portion of Section 23, in Township 34, Range 1, west of the Fifth Meridian in the Province of Alberta, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the easterly boundary of Railway Street with the northerly boundary of Osler Street, as shown on a plan of subdivision of record in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as "Bowden," No. 1954-S; thence easterly along the said northerly boundary of Osler Street a distance of 150 feet; thence northerly and parallel with the easterly boundary of Railway Street a distance of 326 feet; thence westerly and parallel with the said northerly boundary of Osler Street a distance of 150 feet, more or less, to the said easterly boundary of Railway Street; thence southerly along the said easterly boundary of Railway Street a distance of 326 feet, more or less, to the point of commencement—the land herein described comprising 1.12 acres, more or less.
