Upon the recommendation of the Commissioner of Public Works, bearing even date, all the requirements of The Village Ordinance with respect to the establishment of villages having been complied with, the Executive Council advises that, under the provisions of The Village Ordinance in that behalf, the whole of section 23 township 34 range 1 west of the Fifth Meridian be established as a Village under the name of Bowden; that Monday the Twenty-seventh day of June, 1904, be the day fixed for the election of an Overseer of the said Village, and that J. Irwin Davis, of Bowden, Alberta, be appointed to act as Returning Officer at the said election.

To His Honour

The Lieutenant Governor in Council.

The undersigned has the honour to report that, having received satisfactory proof that the area mentioned hereunder is not included within any incorporated City, Town or rural Municipality and that the area contains not less than fifteen occupied dwelling houses, he has, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of The Village Ordinance, caused notices to be posted in three conspicuous places, one of which was the Post Office, within the area announcing the intention to establish the area as a Village after the expiration of thirty days from the date of posting the said notices :

He further reports that such notices were posted at least thirty days prior to the date hereof :

The undersigned therefore begs to recommend that, under the provisions of Section 4 of The Village Ordinance the whole of Section Twenty-three (23) in Township Thirty four, (34) Range One (1) West of the Fifth Meridian be established as a Village; that the Village be given the name of B O W D E I ; that J. Irwin Davis, of Bowden, Alberta, be appointed Returning Officer to act at the election of the first Overseer for the Village; and that the said election for an Overseer for the Village in question be held on Monday the twenty-seventh day of, June, 1904.
