And in the matter of an appli-
cation by the Town of Calmar for
the annexation of certain lands.

Upon the application of the Town of Calmar, in the Province of Alberta; upon reading the consent of the Edmonton District Planning Commission; upon reading the consent of the Municipal District of Leduc No. 75; upon reading the consent of the owners of the property concerned; and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following lands be detached from the Municipal District of Leduc No. 75, and that the same are hereby annexed to the Town of Calmar:

Firstly: All that portion of the north-west quarter of section 30, township 49, range 26, west of the fourth meridian, in the Province of Alberta, described as follows:

Commencing at the point of intersection of the south limit of the road as shown on Road Plan 257 J.Y. and the east boundary of the land subdivided under Plan 627 H.W.; thence southerly along the said east boundary and the production thereof 150 feet; thence easterly and parallel to the said south limit of the said road 200 feet; thence northerly and parallel to the said east boundary of the said Plan 627 H.W. to the said south limit of the said road; thence westerly along the said south limit to the point of commencement; containing 0.69 of an acre, more or less;

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.

Secondly: All those portions of the said north-west quarter of section 30 and the south-west quarter of section 31 in the said township and range shown as road on Plans 3692 J. and 257 J.Y. which lie east of the production southerly of the east boundary of the land subdivided under Plan 2138 H.W. and west of a line drawn parallel to the east boundary of the land subdivided under said Plan 627 H.W. through a point on the said south limit of the said Road 257 J.Y. 200 feet east of the said east boundary of the said Plan 627 H.W.;

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.

This Order shall become effective on 30th day of December, 1960.
