**INCORPORATION OF VILLAGE OF CANMORE INTO A TOWN**

Edmonton, Monday, May 16, 1966.

The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated May 13th, 1966, stating that:

Whereas the Council of the Village of Canmore has petitioned to have the Village incorporated into a Town; and

Whereas a meeting of the electors was held on May 3rd, 1966, at which meeting a motion was passed to petition for the incorporation of the Village into a Town; and

Whereas the Village of Canmore contains over seven hundred inhabitants; and

Whereas the Secretary-Treasurer has furnished satisfactory proof of compliance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, being chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, with respect to the formation of a town;

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that the request to form the Village of Canmore into a Town be acceded to, so that on and from the first day of June, 1966 the Village of Canmore shall be known and designated as the town of Canmore and shall comprise the following lands:

In range 10, west of the fifth meridian, in township 24, the north-west quarter of section 28, that part of the north-east quarter of section 29 lying north and east of the Bow River, that part of section 31 lying north and east of the Bow River, that part of section 32 lying north and east of the Bow River and west of the west boundary of the Trans-Canada Highway, that part of section 33 lying south and west of the west boundary of the Trans-Canada Highway; in township 25, that part of the south half of section 5 lying west of the west boundary of the Trans-Canada Highway, that part of the south-east quarter of section 6 lying east of the Bow River.

The Executive Council further advises, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, that the present Council of the Village of Canmore shall be deemed to be the council of the Town of Canmore until the 24th day of October, 1966, and that the said council prepare for the election of a mayor and six councillors to take office on the 24th day of October, 1966, in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act in that behalf, and that the term of office of the Mayor and councillors so elected shall be governed by sections 43 and 102 of the aforementioned The Town and Village Act.
