TOWN OF CARSTAIRS DESIGNATED

Edmonton, Tuesday, August 23, 1966.

The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated August 10th, 1966, stating that:

Whereas the council of the Village of Carstairs has petitioned to have the Village incorporated into a Town; and

Whereas a meeting of the electors was held on July 20th, 1966 at which meeting a motion was passed to petition for incorporation of the Village into a Town; and

Whereas the Village of Carstairs contains over seven hundred inhabitants; and

Whereas the Secretary-Treasurer has furnished satisfactory proof of compliance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, being chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, with respect to the formation of a Town:

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that the request to form the Village of Carstairs into a Town be and is hereby acceded to so that on and from the first day of September, 1966 the Village of Carstairs shall be known and designated as the Town of Carstairs and shall comprise the following lands:

Those parts of township 30, range 1, west of the fifth meridian, described as follows:

The south-east quarter of section 17.

That part of the north-east quarter of section 8 comprising registered plan 262 L.; those parts of registered plan 2391 J.K. and the north halves of legal subdivisions 15 and 16 not included in registered plan 262 L.; That part of the aforementioned section 8 described as follows:

Commencing at the intersection of the south limit of registered plan 262 L. with the east boundary of the said quarter section, thence south-westerly along the south limit of said plan to the south-west corner of Lot 4, Block D of the said plan 262 L., thence south-easterly along the production of the west boundary of said Lot D four hundred feet to a point, thence north-easterly parallel with the south-easterly limit of said plan 262 L. to the easterly limit of the said quarter section, thence north along the easterly limit to the point of commencement;

The easterly 461.2 feet of the westerly 946.75 feet of the south-easterly 308.5 feet of section 16, containing 3.26 acres more or less; and further, that the present council of the Village of Carstairs shall be deemed to be the council of the Town of Carstairs until the 24th day of October, 1966, and that the said council prepare for the election of a Mayor and six councillors to take office on the 24th day of October, 1966 in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act in that behalf, and that the term of office of the Mayor and councillors so elected shall be governed by sections 43 and 102 of the aforementioned The Town and Village Act.
