ESTABLISHMENT OF VILLAGE.

Edmonton, Friday, November 26, 1909.

Under the provisions of The Village Act, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order that the south half of the north-west quarter of Section 35; the south-west quarter of Section 35; the north half of the north-west quarter of Section 26, and the north half of the north-east quarter of Section 27, all in Township 37 Range 14 west of the Fourth Meridian, be established a Village; that the Village be given the name of Castor; that E. H. Matthias, of Castor, be Returning Officer for the purpose of acting at the election of the first Council of the Village, and that the meeting for nomination of candidates for the office of Councillor shall be held on Monday, the 3rd day of January, 1910.
