It is ordered that the following parcel of land be separated from the Village of Crossfield, in accordance with the provisions of Part VI of The Public Utilities Act, 1923—

The north-west quarter of Section 25, in Township 28, Range 1, west of the Fifth Meridian, in the Province of Alberta, containing 160 acres, more or less, excepting thereout 2 acres, more or less, for a roadway, as shown a plan filed in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta Land Registration District as No. 2595-0--the land herein described containing 158 acres, more or less.
