Edmonton, Monday, April 23, 1906.

Under the provisions of The Village Ordinance, His Honour the Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice of the Executive Council, has been pleased to order the establishment of Section 9 Township 45 Range 16 west of the Fourth Meridian as a Village under the name of Daysland; that Monday, the Fourteenth day of May, 1906, be the day fixed for the election of an Overseer of the said Village, and that Frank P. Layton, of Daysland, be appointed to act as Returning Officer at the said election.
