The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honorable the Attorney General, dated March 22nd 1907, wherein he states that he has had under consideration the petition of the Overseer of the Village of Daysland for the erection of the said Village into a town municipality, under the provisions of "The Municipal Amendment Ordinance, 1901."

The Minister further reports that satisfactory proof of the preliminary acts and requirements requisite to the erection of the said Village into a Town has been furnished.

Upon consideration of the foregoing report and on the recommendation of the Honorable the Attorney General the Executive Council advises that Proclamation of His Honor the Lieutenant Governor do issue proclaiming that on and after the 2nd day of April 1907 the said Village of Daysland be erected into a town municipality to be known as the TOWN OF DAYSLAND, and that the area of the said Town of Daysland consist of all of Section nine (9); the South half of Section sixteen (16); the South West quarter of Section fifteen (15); the West half of Section ten (10); the North-West quarter of Section three (3); the North half of Section four (4), all in Township forty-five (45) Range Sixteen (16) West of the Fourth Meridian in the Province of Alberta; and that Robert J. Dinning of Daysland, Alberta, be named as the Returning Officer for the holding of the first election of Mayor and Councillors for the said Town.




