In the matter of The Public
Utilities Act, and in the matter
of an application by the Calgary
and Edmonton Land Company,
Limited, for the separation of
certain land from the Town of
Didsbury.

Upon the application of the Calgary and Edmonton Land Company,
Limited, upon hearing counsel for the applicants and for the Town of
Didsbury, and upon reading the material filed:

It is ordered that the south-west quarter of Section 19 in Township
31, Range 1, west of the Fifth Meridian, containing 160 acres more or
less, excepting thereout, firstly, 6.02 acres more or less for the right-of-
way of the Calgary and Edmonton Railway as shown on a plan of
said right-of-way filed in the Land Titles Office for the South Alberta
Land Registration District as "Ry. 9," and, secondly, those portions
of said quarter Section as shown on plans of record in said Land Titles
Office as Didsbury 1456 K., 110-0, and 3940 A.K., respectively, con-
taining 14.22 acres more or less; the land herein comprised containing
139.76 acres more or less, be separated from the Town of Didsbury,
subject to the provisions of Section 86a of The Public Utilities Act.
