And in the matter of an application by the Town of Edson for the withdrawal of certain parcels of land from the Town of Edson.

Upon the application of the Town of Edson for the withdrawal of certain parcels of land from the Town of Edson; upon reading the consent of the Department of Municipal Affairs; upon reading the consent of the Director of Surveys for the Department of Public Works, and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following parcels of land be separated from the incorporated limits of the Town of Edson, in accordance with the provisions of Fart VI of The Public Utilities Act, 1923:

(1) All lands including roadways now within the limits of the Town of Edson and situate south of the railway right-of-way and extra railway right-of-way of the Grand Trunk Pacific Railway, as shown on Railway ... Plan 1118 C.L.

(2) North-cast quarter of Section 22, in Township 53, Range 17, west of the Fifth Meridian, containing 159 acres (more or less), and the road allowance to the north of said quarter section.

(3) The roadway between the north-west quarter and the southwest quarter of Section 17, Township 53, Range 17, west of the Fifth Meridian, as shown on Road Plan 6901 E.U.

And it is further ordered that the lands so ordered to be separated from the Town of Edson be added to and form part of the lands included in Local Improvement District No. 555.

This Order is to take effect as from the 1st day of January, 1942.
