VILLAGE OF ELK POINT TO BE DESIGNATED AS THE TOWN
OF ELK POINT

Edmonton, Tuesday, January 9, 1962.

The Executive Council has had under consideration the report of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, dated December 29th, 1961, stating that:

Whereas the Council of the Village of Elk Point has petitioned to have the Village incorporated as a Town; and

Whereas a meeting of the electors was held on Monday, November 20th, 1961, at which meeting a motion was passed to petition for the incorporation of the Village into a Town; and

Whereas the Village of Elk Point contains over seven hundred inhabitants; and

Whereas the Secretary-Treasurer of the Village has furnished satisfactory proof of compliance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act, being chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, with respect to the formation of a Town:

Therefore, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, the Executive Council advises that the request to form the Village of Elk Point into a town be acceded to, so that on and from the 1st day of January, 1962, the Village of Elk Point shall be known and designated as the Town of Elk Point and shall comprise the following lands:

All that part of the east half of section 1 in township 57, range 7, lying north of the south boundary of the station grounds of the Canadian National Railway as shown on Railway Plan 5746 CL

That part of legal subdivision 5 lying north of the south boundary of the Canadian National Railways right of way as shown on Railway plan 5746 CL., and all of legal subdivisions 12 and 13 in section 6, township 57, range 6.

All of the above lands lying west of the fourth meridian. The Executive Council further advises, upon the recommendation of the Honourable the Minister of Municipal Affairs, that in accordance with the provisions of section 29 of The Town and Village Act, being chapter 338 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1955, the present council of the Village of Elk Point shall be deemed to be the council of the Town of Elk Point until the 29th day of October, 1962, and that the said council prepare for the election of a mayor and six councillors to take office on the 29th day of October, 1962, in accordance with the provisions of The Town and Village Act in that behalf, and that the terms of office of the mayor and councillors so elected shall be governed by sections 43 and 102 of The Town and Village Act.
