In the matter of The Town and Village Act:

And in the matter of an application by the Village of Elk Point, for the annexation of an outlying area adjacent thereto but not included within the limits thereof.

Upon the petition of the Council of the Village of Elk Point; upon reading the said petition, the Abstracts of Title of the lands in question and the written consents of all property owners affected and the Municipal District of St. Paul, No. 542, and the other material filed in support of the said petition:

It is ordered, that the following lands be annexed to the Village of Elk Point, in accordance with the provisions of Section 21 of The Town and Village Act (being Chapter 150 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1942), namely:

All that portion of the south half of the north-east quarter of Section 1, Township 57, Range 7, west of the Fourth Meridian, not included within the limits of the Village of Elk Point.

This order shall take effect, as, and from the 1st day of July, 1947.
