And in the matter of an ap-
plication by the Village of Elk
Point, for the annexation of cer-
tain lands.

Upon the application of the Village of Elk Point, in the Province of Alberta; upon reading the consent of the Municipal District of St. Paul No. 86; upon reading the consent of the Director of Town and Rural Planning for the Province; upon reading the consent of the owners of the property concerned; and upon reading the other material filed:

It is ordered that the following lands be detached from the Municipal District of St. Paul No. 86, and that the same be and are hereby annexed to the Village of Elk Point.

All of legal subdivision 15, containing 40 acres, more or less, and all that portion of legal subdivision 16 which lies west of the west limit of the road widening as shown on Road Plan 530 J.Y., containing 39.5 acres, more or less, in section 1, township 57, range 7, west of the fourth meridian, in the said Province.

Reserving thereout all mines and minerals.

This order shall be effective on the 30th day of December, 1958.
